Safety Precautions

 To do so will result in damage & loss of acoustic control.
- Clear the path beneath the ceiling track through which panels will move.
- Always move panels at a walking pace, one group at a time.
- All panel pass doors must be closed & secured when panels are relocated

Moderco wall systems are engineered & manufactured to operate easily & with a minimum of force. Designate & train specific individuals in their movement, set-up & care emphasizing responsibility & care.

AFTER INSTALLATION THIS FOLDING PARTITION REQUIRES VERY LITTLE MAINTENANCE.

1. Should some roughness develop in the supporting track when moving the panels, wipe off the inside of the bottom lips of the track with a rag.

2. If it is necessary to clean the panel surfaces, use warm water and soap, with a soft scrubbing brush.

Avoid chemical cleaners or strong detergents.




Operation: Panels stacked against the wall (no pocket)

WITH HINGED CLOSURE PANEL



- 1. OBSERVE ALL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS. (see page 2)
 - 2. Gently slide out first group of panels about 2 m. (6" - 0') from stack bundle.



3. Open panels and push on the face of panel to its position in line with track.



4. Gently push panels to far end opposite to stack.




5. Once the bottom seal reaches a wall or another panel, push the panels until they pass the pivot point of the bottom seals.



Repeat steps 1 to 5 with each remaining panels.

6. When all panels are in line across room and seals are locked, swing hinged closure panel to closed position in line with all panels.






WITH TELESCOPIC CLOSURE PANEL



- 1. OBSERVE ALL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS. (see page 2)
 - 2. Gently slide out first group of panels about 2 m. (6"-0") from stack bundle.



3. Open panels and push on the face of panel to its position in line with track.



4. Gently push panels to far end opposite to stack.



5. Once the bottom seal reaches a wall or another panel, push the panels until they pass the pivot point of the bottom seals.



Repeat steps 1 to 5 with each remaining panels.

FOR THE LAST PAIR OF PANELS

6. See operation 6a to 6e on page 5 (NON ACOUSTICAL POCKET DOORS SELECTION)




All hands, fingers & other objects should be kept clear of all panel-meeting edges.

Operation: Panels stacked in a pocket



With acoustical pocket doors Follow operations 1 to 5 on page 4


6. a) When all panels are in line across room and seals are locked, gently slide out the last pair of panels.




b) Close the pocket doors.




c) Unfold the panels and put it in a straight position.



d) Gently slide it against last panel.




 e) Place operating handle into opening on face of panel and turn to expand the telescopic against door to seal folding partition.




7. To stack folding partition, reverse above steps from 6 to 1.

With non acoustical pocket doors or no pocket Follow operations 1 to 5 on page 4


a) When all panels are in line across room and seals are locked, gently slide out the last pair of panels.




b) Unfold the panels and put it in a straight position.




c) Gently slide it against last panel.



d) Place operating handle into opening on face of panel and turn to expand the telescopic against wall to seal folding partition.




e) Close the pocket doors (if applicable).




7. To stack folding partition , reverse above steps from 6 to 1 .



"U" Shape Pass Door Operation




Step 1: Once the bottom seal reaches a wall or another panel, push the panels until they go past the pivot point of the bottom seal.




WARNING

Step 3: Engage the mechanism located on face of the panel furthest away from you as described in step 2.




♠ WARNING

"L" Shape Pass Door Operation (Signature 842 only)




Step 1: Engage the mechanism located on face of the panel closest to you by placing operating key in face opening and turning one half revolution.



All panel pass doors must be closed & secured when panels are relocated



Step 2: Engage the mechanism located on face of the panel furthest away from you as described in step 1.
