Safety Precautions



IN ORDER TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR OTHER PROBLEMS YOU MUST:

- Moderco wall systems are engineered & manufactured to operate easily & with a minimum of force.
- It is dangerous for children, or any unqualified person, to operate electric walls.
- All hands, fingers & other objects should be kept clear of all panel-meeting edges.
- Clear the path beneath the ceiling track through which panels will move.
- All panel pass doors must be closed & secured when panels are operated
- Moderco Inc. is not and will not be liable for any bodily, material or other damages suffered in case of negligent or careless use of its products.

This set of instructions deals with routine but necessary operational techniques as well as day-to-day care & maintenance instructions for your Moderco Operable Wall Systems. It is highly recommended that you follow all suggestions noted in order to ensure many years of trouble free operation.



Maintenance

AFTER INSTALLATION THIS FOLDING PARTITION REQUIRES MAINTENANCE ONCE A YEAR OR AS REQUIRED.



Moderco wall systems are engineered & manufactured to operate easily & with a minimum of force. Designate & train specific individuals in their movement, set-up & care emphasizing responsibility & care.

♠ WARNING

It is dangerous for children, or any unqualified person, to operate moveable walls.

1. DRIVE MECHANISM

This is located above the track at the stacking end of the partition.

2. SPEED REDUCER

This reducer contains the proper amount of mobile 600 w cylinder oil when it left the factory. It should be checked annually. If low, add some oil as above or equal.

3. CAUTION

Never completely fill the reducer with oil. It will cause oil leakage and overheating which result in rapid wear of oil seals, bearings and gears. The oil should be on a level with the oil level plug never any higher.

4. DRIVE CHAIN

The chain must be uniformly greased, without extras (that could drip or stain) to enable a smooth operation. A lack of lubrification could cause a noisy and/or damageable wear. The chain should be tight enough to avoid a hanging curve outside the track but not excessive. Tighten the adjusting nuts at the end of the tensioner spring. A chain not properly adjusted can cause damages to the drive system.

- 5. Should some roughness develop in the supporting track when moving the panels, wipe off the inside of the bottom lips of the track with a rag. When clean, apply small quantity of light grease to the track lips at intervals across the full opening and stacking area. Relocate the panels across the opening so as to evenly distribute the grease along the entire length of the track.
- If it is necessary to clean the panel surfaces, use warm water and soap, with a soft scrubbing brush.
 Avoid chemical cleaners or strong detergents.
- 7. Should replacement parts be required, or for other information, contact your nearest Moderco distributor. Refer to our web site www.moderco.com
- 8. This system is designed to be fully extended and/or fully retracted. Partial operation of the partitions (stopping and reversing operation in the middle of the opening) is prohibited as it can damage either the track, the trolleys, the hinges and even in some cases the panels.



- Operable partition will stack against wall and will automatically stop.
- Remove keys and place in safe location to prevent unauthorized use of wall.

TO EXTEND OPERABLE PARTITION ACROSS ROOM


- Unlock and open fully the pocket doors and hold in place with door holders.
- Check path that partition is to take to make sure there are no obstructions in its way.
- Insert keys into spring loaded key switches and turn to EXTEND position, maintaining pressure against spring loaded safety mechanism at all time.
- Operable partition will extend across room and automatically stop at bumper wall.
- Remove keys and place in safe location to prevent unauthorized use of wall.
- Release door holders on pocket doors, close and lock in place.

TO STACK OPERABLE PARTITION

- Unlock and open fully the pocket doors and hold in place with door holders.
- Check both sides of operable partition to ensure that there are no obstructions either side of wall.
- Insert keys into spring loaded key switches and turn to STACK position, maintaining pressure against spring loaded safety mechanism at all time.
- Operable partition will stack against wall and will automatically stop.
- Remove keys and place in safe location to prevent unauthorized use of wall.
- Release door holders on pocket doors, close and lock in place.



The area immediately beneath the track should remain free of objects when panels are being relocated.
